Objective A

Discussion/Suggestions for the Board of Directors:

- 1. Formalize the relationship with the Section on Geriatrics for producing the Hip Fracture guideline in process that parallels the relationship with the Hand Therapy Section.
- 2. Consider creating clinical practice guidelines for the following topics:
 - a. Anterior Cruciate Ligament Injuries: Prevention and Rehabilitation
 - b. Throwing Injuries to the Shoulder and Elbow: Prevention and Rehabilitation** with potential collaboration with the American Orthopaedic Society of Sports Medicine and maybe the Sports Physical Therapy Section, APTA

- 3. Appoint Phil McClure and Tony Delitto to another term as Advisory Panel Members.
- 4. Appoint another individual as an Advisory Panel Member to replace Rusty Smith. I suggest Todd Davenport. Consider keeping this panel at 5 members instead of 6 and not replacing JW Matheson.
- 5. Work will begin on revisions of the Heel Pain and the Neck Pain clinical practice guidelines for 2013.
