The following was presented as a part of the President's report:

- A. Proposed topics and timeline for Occupational Health continuing education was presented by Doug Flint.
- B. CSM regular programming:

Will be discussed further on next call. For now, the group needs to think of topics and a potential speaker pool, keeping in mind not to duplicate the Disney ergonomist idea, as it would duplicate previous programming.

C. Podcasts - Chris Studebaker

Chris suggested the group check out APTA/PT Journal/etc. podcasts for an idea of what is offered. A question was raised regarding whether or not APTA would offer assistance with developing these podcasts? Lorena raised a concern regarding the amount of man hours and the time to produce podcasts.

Lorena clarified to the group that, yes, at this time the CE series is taking the place of specialization. As a reference, both the Section on Geriatrics and Private Practice Sections have already developed a successful CE series.

Pam and Tara presented info on budgets/how to plan funding/how speakers can be paid.

E. Reiterate timeframe:
