The Purpose of the Award is to:


- Highlight innovative, timely, and/or unique elements in residency or fellowship education, practice or research

GOAL: Grow payment for services by demonstrating the value of physical therapy

- AOPT: The Payment and Value Workgroup In coordination with our constituents (e.g APTA, Sections and Academies), create and disseminate 2-3 resources or initiatives to enhance or ensure payment for delivery of PT services by December 31, 2021
 - ORF-SIG: Propose educational program to highlight the value of Residencies/Fellowships on creating culture and employee engagement in medical institutions (Complete by Oct 30th 2021)

GOAL: Promote the development and implementation of evidence to best practice

- Develop and disseminate innovative and varied educational opportunities (i.e. micro-learning, new types of podcasts); seeking 6-8 innovative and varied learning products by December 1, 2021
 - ORF SIG: Survey to programs about mentorship June 30,2021
 - ORF-SIG: Develop and disseminate an ABPTRFE Q and A resource to support residency and fellowship programs - March 30,2021
- Facilitate the translation of evidence to practice of the use of patient-reported and performance-based tests and measures appropriate to orthopaedic practice; developing 2-3 implementation methods by Nov 1, 2021
 - ORF SIG: Develop website to include resident/fellow poster publications for shared learning.

GOAL: Position members as experts in managing movement and functional performance impairment

- AOPT Leverage #choosePT to improve public awareness of PT. (focus on consumer)
 - ORF-SIG: Highlight Res/Fellow Poster awards at CSM via AOPT social media blasts and publish in OPTP Q2 and Q4 of 2021
 - ORF-SIG: Provide alternative CSM Career Development reception to promote the field to prospective residents and fellows May 2021 / November 2021
 - ORF-SIG: Develop a Program Highlight opportunity to recognize different Res/Fellowship programs.
 - ORF-SIG: Enhance Applicant sharing program survey within membership for recruitment (March 30,2021)
 - ORF-SIG: Develop Interested Resident / Fellow registry for ORF-SIG members by June 2021-
- AOPT: Produce 3-4 educational resources (in any format) on the value proposition of the PT professional for current practices and as an aid to future employment/advancement opportunities; complete by December 1, 2021.
 - ORF-SIG: Move "Residency/Fellowship pre con" to purchasable micro learning option (July 31, 2021)
 - ORF SIG: Propose educational program to highlight the value of Residencies/Fellowships on creating culture and employee engagement in medical institutions (May 31,2021)
