Poster Award: CSM 2022- Research Committee -Kathleen Geist

The Purpose of the Award is to:

- Highlight innovative, timely, and/or unique elements in residency or fellowship education, practice or research.
- Provide an avenue for residents and fellows to showcase their scholarly projects
- Encourage best practices, with respect to Physical Therapy evaluation, diagnosis, treatment planning, and outcome assessment.

Eligibility:

- Members and student members of the ORF-SIG
- Abstracts should reflect current standards of orthopaedic practice.
- Study type may include prospective or retrospective designs
- Any work that has been presented at a national/international conference or has previously been accepted for publication/published is excluded

Mentorship Survey Update

- Write up of survey manuscript underway
- Platform/Poster submission with mentorship survey data at CSM 2021
- Key takeaways
 - Variability in mentoring delivery across residencies
 - Mentoring most often occurs weekly
 - Virtual mentoring options are being utilized by less than ½ of programs
 - COVID-19 impacted mentoring delivery

Conclusions: Orthopaedic residency and fellowship mentoring is delivered using a variety of methods, and mentors and program directors cross-cover multiple positions in residency and fellowship programs. Identifying the structure and delivery of residency and fellowship mentoring provides an opportunity for enhanced understanding of optimal mentoring approaches across programs for participants.

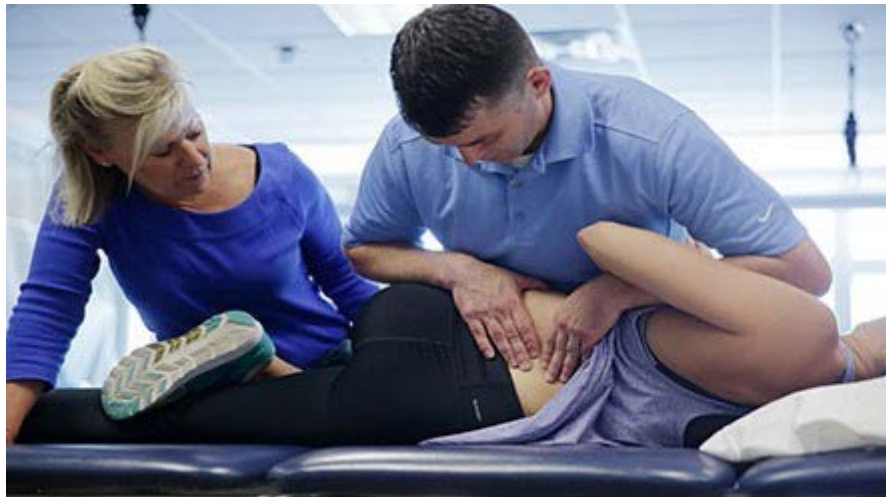
Future Planning
