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1. Accomplishments in the past year

In the past 12 months we have completed the interviews of 9 people who have had gender assignment surgery (GAS). The majority of people have had surgeries to transition from female to male. We are focusing on recruiting people who have transitioned male to female. We have only been able to recruit three providers to date. More provider interviews scheduled in the coming weeks.

Research personnel have completed training for the directed content analysis of the interview transcripts and that process has begun.

2. Provide a one-paragraph summary of results or abstract suitable for posting on the Academy website.

Little is known about the impact of gender assignment surgeries on health-related quality of life, particularly as they relate to musculoskeletal pain and dysfunction. Our purpose is to examine and extend the role of orthopaedic physical therapists in the care of pain and musculoskeletal dysfunction in transgender individuals after GAS. Focus groups will inform the development of a broader survey of individuals after GAS and providers. To date we have completed interviews of nine individuals after GAS and three health care providers. Analysis will explore the themes of pain type, barriers to care, satisfaction with care, types of musculoskeletal dysfunction after surgery and the impact of any treatment after surgery.

 The budget does not reflect the salary for the research assistant. This discrepancy was identified in the end of year reconciliation and it was noted her salary was being drawn from a different account. The grants office has indicated that they will be moving her salary that was not captured onto the project. The research assistant has had some difficulty completing the work assigned and she left the university, electing not to continue with the project. We are currently interviewing to fill that position.
