**Please submit the following documents:**

1. NIH Biosketch (3 page maximum)
2. Confirm membership of the Academy of Orthopaedic Physical Therapy
3. Statement of health services, and specifically in implementation science, knowledge translation research interests (1/2 - 1 page)
4. Proposed project for Implementation Science (1 page):

The proposed project must be based on a currently published AOPT Clinical Practice Guideline. It is not expected that the proposed project encompasses all recommendations in a given CPG, but rather a component(s) of a CPG.

Please provide a draft of the proposed project, providing details of: project description, supporting evidence, proposed setting/ sites, involved stakeholders (clinical staff, managers, administrators, etc.), draft specific aims, methodology, and potential impact.

Applications will be reviewed by the CoHSTAR Executive Committee and AOPT representatives.

*NOTE: 5 applications will be selected for a travel award stipend.*
