GUIDELINES:

31 The role of the BOD liaison is to provide a consistent contact person who could be a resource or
32 “go between” for each of the committee chairs, special interests groups (SIG) or any external
33 organization representatives recognized by the Orthopaedic Section. It is the responsibility of
34 the committee chairs, SIG representatives or representatives of external organizations to contact
35 their BOD liaison by Phone/E-mail **five weeks prior to the CSM, July Board Meeting and**
36 **October Board Meeting.** The communication will be especially important prior to the July and
37 October meetings where not all committee chairs are present. A review of discussion items, “To
38 Do’s” and current issues or projects would be in order during these contacts. Committee reports
39 should be E-Mailed to the BOD liaison prior to submission to the Section office for distribution.
40 If timely communication does not occur as outlined, it is the responsibility of the BOD liaison to
41 contact the committee chair, SIG representative or representative of an external organization to
42 insure consistent communication.

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- 1 ▪ This “Guideline” will be sent out annually by the Section office staff and as needed when
- 2 committee chairs change.
- 3 ▪ The rationale for emailing committee reports to the appropriate Board liaison prior to
- 4 submission to the Section office is to improve communication and stimulate possible
