Policy: Nominating Committee

Purpose: To ensure that the Nominating Committee carries out their responsibilities in

selecting appropriate, qualified candidates for office in the Academy of

Orthopaedic Physical Therapy (AOPT) election.

Scope: This policy pertains to the Nominating Committee Chair and Committee

members, and AOPT Special Interest Groups (SIGs) and Education Interest

Groups (EIGs)

Responsibilities: AOPT Nominating Committee, AOPT Staff

- 1. The Nominating Committee members are elected to office by the AOPT PT and PTA membership.
- 2. Nominating Committee terms are 3 years, with the first 2 years as Member, and the third year as Nominating Committee Chair.
- 3. Nominating Committee terms begin and end at the close of the Membership Meeting at the Combined Sections Meeting.
- 4. The Nominating Committee is responsible for recruiting, reviewing, and selecting AOPT members to run for open AOPT elected positions each year.
- 5. If the policies are not followed you are in violation of the policies.
- 6. Adhere to and execute Standard Operating Procedures.
